The mother was again pregnant but lost her child in the 5th month after that she became very ill and was hospitalized. Unfortunately she got infection and they could not save her.

The last thing the mother said to her husband before she closed her eyes and died was: "Please take good care of my little Tabitha."

It was her great worry, what would happen to her almost 2 year old baby.

The father came to us and shared his sorrow and had a question for us which was if we were willing to take his little Tabitha into our orphanage so she could have a save and good home and be together with her big brother who have now been at the school for 2 years. We said yes to this as we felt we should help the father and the child.

The father is having such a hard time and he said: "My wife was the one who ran our home and she was my backbone. I am nothing without her."

We want to do what we can for this little girl so she will have a safe upbringing. The children at the home are already happy for her and want to carry her around.

I wonder if there is anyone that would be willing to sponsor her economically so that she can stay at the orphanage?

It costs 250kr pr month.
